

How to Qualify for the SaskTel Tankard or the Bunge Pinnacle

IMPORTANT DATES

- Playdown registration deadline – December 1, 2025 at 11:59pm
- Points Cutoff Deadline – December 1st at 11:59pm*
- Last Chance Qualifiers – December 11-14th, 2025
- Provincials – January 5th-11th, 2026 in Melville, Saskatchewan

PATHWAYS TO QUALIFY

***Teams will be qualified in the following order:**

- 3 Teams Saskatchewan Curling Tour (includes all sanctioned events in Saskatchewan, via Curling Zone)*
- 3 Teams Canadian Team Ranking System
- 3 Teams Last Chance Qualifier

PROCESS

1. Register for provincial playdowns on [CURLSASK's Curling I/O](#), any team wanting the chance to participate in provincials must register for playdowns. Teams that qualify on points will not be required to play in the Last Chance.
2. Register for the Saskatchewan Curling Tour events on [Sask Curling Tour](#)
3. Follow along the race for points on the Leaderboards on the [Men's](#) and [Women's](#) website pages.
4. December 2nd final points will be calculated and teams qualifying on points will be announced.
5. The remaining teams will be contacted for information on the Last Chance Qualifier.

****SCT Points will be counted to a maximum number of events, based on Curling Canada's point calculation system. The CTRS ranking will allow a defined number of "maximum events" throughout the season until reaching the full 8. The following are the dates and maximum events allowable at each date:**

1 August 2025 to 15 September 2025 = one event allowed

16 September 2025 to 6 October 2025 = two events allowed

7 October 2025 to 20 October 2025 = three events allowed

21 October 2025 to 3 November 2025 = four events allowed

4 November 2025 to 1 December 2025 = five events allowed
