

Job Opportunity – Ice Technician

The Lanigan & District Curling Club is looking for an Ice Technician for the 2025-2026 Curling Season. This position would commence December 2025 and conclude April 2026, with the possibility of rehire for subsequent curling seasons.

The L&DCC boasts 4 sheets of ice, a lobby area with a full kitchen and office, as well as a lounge/mezzanine upstairs with lockers, a great view of the ice, and a fully serviced bar. The club hosts 4-5 bonspiels per season, league curling two nights per week, youth league curling one afternoon per week, school curling two afternoons per week, as well as other events throughout the season.

This position reports to the L&DCC Board.

Preference will be given to those who have completed the Certified Ice Technicians Course, but training may be provided to the successful applicant if needed.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Ice maintenance throughout the season (pebbling and scraping)
- Prepping ice for league, bonspiels, and competitions
- Maintaining/servicing the ice and ice-related equipment
- Assisting in ice removal at the end of the season
- General building maintenance throughout the season
- Other duties as assigned

The monthly salary range for this position is \$1,200 to \$1,600. Placement in the range will be based on experience and qualifications of the successful applicant as assessed by the Board. This position is, on average, around 15 hrs/week.

Applications should contain relevant experience, education, and 2 references. This posting will stay open until a suitable candidate is found, but applications received on or before **November 21, 2025** will be given preference.
