These rule amendments (Thresholds) apply to curlers wishing to participate in the CURLSASK Curling Club Championships. Curling Canada's Rules for the National Championship still apply.

Our goal is to keep this event for club curlers. CURLSASK has made the following rule amendments (Adjusted Thresholds) provincially in which it feels defines a competitive curler as well as addressing the fact that currently, all but two provincial championships are open events.

Competitive curlers are curlers which are curling in WCT events or qualified to compete in Provincial Tankards and Prairie Pinnacles or anyone who has won a Provincial Championship, participated in a Canadian Championship (except Wheelchair) or in any other championships and should be limited in this event.

- A. A team must register the event with minimum 4 curlers.
- B. All team members must be an affiliated member of CURLSASK and registered member of the **same curling club**, paying a full league fee and playing regularly in a league. These qualifications may be verified by CURLSASK. It is the responsibility of the home club to provide an accurate verification if requested by CURLSASK.
- C. Players now WILL NOT be required to curl on the same team all season.
- D. Spare Rules will remain the same.

Saskatchewan's Thresholds 2025-26 season

PLAYERS WHO WILL NOT QUALIFY**

- 1) Any player who has played in a Women's or Men's Provincial Championship and has made the playoffs* (tiebreakers do not count) in the current or previous 3 curling seasons.
- 2) Any Player that has won a Women's or Men's Provincial Championship, played in a Canadian Championship (except Wheelchair) or won any of the following Provincial Championships in the current or past 3 seasons:
 - a) U21 Junior
 - b) U18 Junior
 - c) Senior
 - d) Team Mixed
 - e) Mixed Doubles
 - f) Masters
- 3) Any Player that has made the playoffs* (but did not win the event) in any of the following championships in the current or past 1 season:
 - g) U21 Junior
 - h) U18 Junior
 - i) Senior

- j) Team Mixed
 - k) Mixed Doubles
 - l) Masters
- 4) Any player who played in the Canadian Curling Club Championships the previous season (i.e. last season's Provincial Winner)
- 5) Any player who has played in an Elite Curling Canada Event or a Grand Slam Event in the current or 3 previous seasons.

ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS

- Each team may only have 1 member on the team that has competed in a Women's (Prairie Pinnacle), Men's (Tankard) or Mixed Doubles Provincial Championship in the current or 3 previous seasons and **did not** make the playoffs* in the event they competed in.

Note: Any teams that enter a playdown and after the team is confirmed one of its members competes in another provincial event and NOW DOES NOT qualify under these rules for clubs, that team may replace that player with a player that qualifies (i.e. see point B and C above) and the replacement player may play any position. CURLSASK will provide the umpires with a finalized lineup for each team prior to the start of the event.

*Any event that has more than 4 teams advancing to playoffs (i.e. Mixed Doubles), this rule applies to only the final four teams for that event.

**5th or Alternate players are exempt
